AUDIENCE CAROLS

Item 1 – 'Once in royal David's City' – verses 1 and 2

Junior Choir sing 1st two verses. Afterwards, the Senior Choir sing the 3rd verse processing up the church with their glowsticks. There will be a simple accompaniment on the piano. then the Audience sings the remainder of the verses. Here are the two verses for the Junior Choir
