

Junior Choir for the Music and Merriment Concert

The Junior Concert Choir is a regular and well-established feature of the big St Mary's Winkfield 'Music and Merriment' Christmas Concert on 4 December 2021, at 7:30pm.

We had a lot of fun at our last concert in 2019 – and we will do so in 2021. Here is the 2019 Junior choir – some familiar faces?



Who can be in the Junior choir?

Any child - Y4 to Y7 is a guide – can join – no experience of music required – just keenness to sing with other children. Children will be trained by me in 5 rehearsals to be amazing! It is important that each singer should if possible be at every rehearsal, but we can cope if it is necessary to miss one. Rehearsals are November Sunday evenings 6-7pm, plus a morning rehearsal 11am-12noon on the day of the concert that is: 7/11 6-7; 14/11 6-7; 21/11 6-7, 28/11 6-7 and 4/12 11-12; concert 7:30pm.

What will the children do?

They start the concert by processing up a darkened church holding glowsticks, while singing the first 2 verses of 'Once in Royal David's City'.

Later in the first part of the concert, they perform three Christmassy pieces under my direction, accompanied by Su Mei Kong on the piano.

In the second part of the concert, they sing two verses of an audience carol. They also mime little elephants in a piece with tuba and piano.

Rehearsals

I will personally take rehearsals, with the help of a piano accompanist, and we will also have a lady member of the concert management team present to advise parents about plans. Many parents like to stay to watch rehearsals, so we will always have several responsible adults present for safe-guarding purposes. I myself have a DBS certificate and have been directing the children's choirs for the concert for some years now.

The rehearsals will entail quite focussed work on singing and on the pieces, and children will benefit from singing at home between rehearsal to speed their learning.

Who am I?

I'm Anthony Hodson, a lively 84-year-old; I have been an enthusiastic musician since I was young, have taught in many ways, including after-school club, and also in tutoring children from 7 to 15 in music and other subjects (which I still do).

What do you do next?

Sign up some simple details, have your child take part in rehearsals, and in the concert, and then sit back and enjoy what the children can do! You child can join by you writing to me or giving me details today. It helps us if you can email us a recent photo of your child, to help us to recognise them quickly, but that is absolutely optional.
